From the Pastor...

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal states *"Among the requisites for the celebration of Mass, the sacred vessels are held in special honor, especially the chalice and paten, in which the bread and wine are offered and consecrated, and from which they are consumed. Sacred vessels are to be made from precious metal. If they are made from metal that rusts or from metal less precious than gold, then ordinarily they should be gilded on the inside. In the dioceses of the United States of America, sacred vessels may also be made from other solid materials that, according to the common estimation in each region, are precious, for example, ebony or other hard woods, provided that such materials are suited to sacred use and do not easily break or deteriorate. This applies to all vessels which hold the hosts, such as the paten, the ciborium, the pyx, the monstrance, and other things*

of this kind. As regards chalices and other vessels that are intended to serve as receptacles for the Blood of the Lord, they are to have bowls of non-absorbent material. The base, on the other hand, may be made of other solid and worthy materials."

I share this with you because we have heard the past few weeks in our gospel about Jesus' Bread



of Life Discourse where He says we must eat His flesh and drink His blood. I am hoping to be able to follow these instructions as they are stated. I want you to be aware of the reasons why these changes will be taking place. These are part of the instructions handed on to us from the Church. Please feel free to ask me any questions that you may have related to this topic or of any concerns you may have.
