- ▶ Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence.
- ▶ All Lenten Fridays are days of abstinence.
- ▶ Fasting for those age 18 to 59 means one full meal + two lighter ones.
- ▶ Abstinence for those over 14 years of age means not eating meat.
- ▶ One is not bound to fast if health or the ability to work is affected.

✝ The *St. Cloud Visitor* this week has an excellent insert entitled **LENT 2015**, with lots of information about Lenten practices and opportunities to PRAY, FAST AND GIVE in our diocese.

✝ In addition to our traditional Lenten programs such as the Rice Bowl and the Catholic Relief Services Collection (March 22), we will once again join the Lions Clubs and other area churches and organizations in raising funds and packing FOOD FOR KIDZ at the Community Center on March 28. More information next week.

✝ There are also some special individual resources available at the back of our churches. The Liturgical Press at the Abbey has given us free issues of *Give Us This Day* for the month of February and we have also purchased copies of *The Word Among Us* so that you can have the daily mass texts and commentaries for each day of Lent to reflect on and to prepare for daily or Sunday mass.

✝ Deacon Rick will have Stations of the Cross and a Communion Service in one of our parishes each Friday, while I will have Stations of the Cross followed by the Mass in one of the other two. Watch the bulletin for the rotation schedule.

At Mass last weekend, we heard Bishop Kettler ask for our support of the 2015 Annual Diocesan Appeal. Grant Distribution Awarded to Sacred Heart
