

That offering is to help support the priest who offers the mass, and when that mass stipend is sent to missionary priests, it is often the only income they have to live on for that day.

It can be difficult for us to imagine what it might have been like to be those fishermen casting nets into the Sea of Galilee. There you are, minding your own business, fishing as you did every other day of your life, only to have a man such as Jesus appear and tell you what to do.

Some of us might enjoy angling for sport, but few of us depend on fishing for our livelihoods in this part of the world. So, perhaps we could imagine what it would be like if Jesus stopped by our office, school or other place of employment one afternoon, passing on his way to a speaking engagement in the next town. The expectation of

us would be the same -- indeed is the same -- as it was of Simon, Andrew, James and John in the early days of Jesus' ministry. We remain called to come after him, to follow his lead and continue the work of evangelizing in the world.

Reflect: How is Jesus calling me to show up and follow Him in the world today? How am I doing at this key expectation of being a disciple? How

would I respond if the call happened today in the midst of the craziness of my daily life?
