From the Pastor...

VENITE, ADOREMUS, Come, let us adore!

Wise men came bearing gifts to confirm their star talk, for the infant Jesus is revealed as the mystery saving everyone—believers and pagans. All people are encompassed in the good new, the promise of the Gospel. All share the same inheritance. All share Christ's body, the New Jerusalem that is the church mothering us to salvation. THE MAGI OR WISEMEN In ancient Iran--also known as Persia--a priest was called a "magus." The plural is "magi". The word "magic" comes from the same root. Magi were experts in astronomy. This was useful in determining the calendar and the end of winter and the spring planting season. They believed that stars and other celestial objects actually influenced, rather than merely coincided with, earthly events. One, or possibly a series of omens, led them to believe that a royal prince had been born in Israel. They were sent as ambassadors to provide tribute to the newborn. The bible does not say how many Magi visited. It is assumed that there were three because of the number of gifts.

MYRRH AND FRANKINCENSE The gifts brought by the Magi were both appropriate and expensive. The value of gold is obvious but what of the other presents? Myrrh is an aromatic substance made from the sap of Myrtle balsam trees found in India, Africa and Saudi Arabia. It is a natural antiseptic and useful as a medicine. Egyptians used myrrh for embalming mummies. It is now used for toothpaste and mouthwash. Incense is a hardened gum that also comes from trees found in the same areas. The word "Frank" comes from an old French word that means "marked." It is a stamp that the incense is "free" from contaminants or "pure". (Franking is still used for free mail rights given to members of Congress.) Incense was used primarily to cover up the smells caused by animal sacrifices. Hence it was connected with worship.

EPIPHANY HOME BLESSING The Holy Family welcomed the Magi on Epiphany. There is a beautiful tradition inspired by this event. Take some chalk and say your own blessing over it with your family. Ask God to welcome strangers to your home during the coming year. Finally write these numbers and letters over the front door of your home: **20 + C + M + B + 15**. The letters represent the traditional names of the Wise Men--Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar.

Immigration Sunday, January 4 Since 2009, the Catholic bishops of Minnesota have designated a Sunday in January, typically the feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, as Immigration Sunday Minnesota. On this day we are reminded that all human beings – regardless of the city, nationality, race, creed or status – are co-heirs, members of the same body, and "partners in the promise in Jesus Christ" (Ephesians 3:6) This includes newcomers to our country and state. Immigration Sunday gives us an opportunity to learn more about the Church's teaching on immigration and raise awareness about immigration issues in Minnesota and beyond.

We are One Family Under God National Migration Week 2015 will take place January 4 – 10 with the theme, "We are One Family Under God," which brings to mind the importance of family in our daily lives. This reminder is particularly important when dealing with the migration phenomenon, as family members are too often separated from one another.

Prayer for National Migration Week 2015

Loving Father, remembering that the Holy Family fled violence and lived for a time as refugees, we ask that you protect all refugee families fleeing persecution, and provide them a place of safety and comfort.

For children who are making perilous journeys, often alone and without the protection of loved ones, we ask that you reunite them with their families and protect them from violence on the journey.

For all migrants, that they not feel compelled to migrate but have opportunities in their homeland where they can thrive and live fully human lives.

Open our hearts so that we may provide hospitality for those who come in search of refuge. Amen.
