Fr. Dan isn't writing anything this week as he's still unpacking and getting settled.

Today's Gospel Reflection

We hear this weekend about Jesus sending his disciples out to preach the gospel, "giving them authority over unclean spirits." Notice how he sent them out...two by two, and with only a walking stick. In simplicity and in companionship they were sent. Bishop Kettler recently reflecting on the new encyclical from Pope Francis, speaks of the need for simplicity of living and companionship. He wrote, "In his letter, Pope Francis talks about the problems of overconsumption, wastefulness and our throwaway culture - one that fails to recognize the value of God's material gifts as well as the gift of the human person. A society that ignores the poor and the immigrant, that allows abortion, assisted-suicide and other attacks on human life, fails to understand how our world's natural ecology is linked to human ecology. In other words, how we treat one another is an indication of how we treat the natural world." We, by the power of Jesus, have authority over unclean spirits, just as the disciples did. Our Pope pointed out the 'unclean spirits' of our day. Now, like the disciples, we are called to go out and spread the good news!

Year of the Consecrated Life Pope Francis announced a year dedicated to the promotion of the Consecrated Life. He asks religious sisters, brothers, and priests to "wake-up the world" with their testimony of faith, holiness and hope. Pope Francis urged the laity to welcome the "Year of Consecrated Life" as a grace for the whole church. He also asked all Christians to be more aware of the gifts of the Holy Spirit which they have received to live as a faithful follower of Christ in our world today. Here is a brief description of the religious community of **Franciscan Poor Clare Nuns, Sauk Rapids** The charism of the Poor Clare Order since the time of its founding by St. Francis and St. Clare of Assisi in the 13th century, and continuing today, is to live in poverty, mutual love and enclosure. Poverty implies not destitution but monastic frugality; not to own but merely to use the things of this world, simply and plainly. This rules out consumerism or ownership. It is very freeing not to be burdened with an overload of things. To live together in mutual love asks us to rejoice in the uniqueness of each person. We rejoice in the joys of each sister and, through empathy, we share her pains, sufferings or setbacks, ever trying to lessen them by sisterly concern, reaching out to her in prayer and service. Living in enclosure invites us to live simply. This removes the inner pressures of hearing or knowing all the happenings and events prevalent in today's world and makes it possible to live simply, fostering a spirit of inner stillness, and to live quietly with and in God. Thus, ongoing prayer allows us to grow in an ever-deepening awareness of others, resulting in intercessory prayer for the world and its needs. It allows a sister to proceed on her monastic journey with serenity and freedom.
