

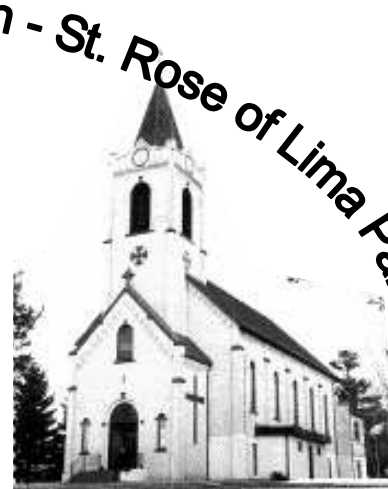

Annual Diocesan Appeal Many of our ill and home-bound sisters and brothers in Christ, across the Diocese of St. Cloud, celebrate Sunday Mass broadcast on television. Getting to a parish is simply too difficult for them. The Annual Diocesan Appeal supports the important ministry of the TV Mass. Thank you for giving to the Appeal!

Food for Kidz In just 4 weeks, our 4th Annual **Food for Kidz** program participants will gather at the Community Center to package food for hungry children in our area and throughout the world! The children of Sacred Heart School are on board again, each of them doing extra chores at home to earn money so they can reach their goal of making a \$1,500 donation to **Food for Kidz**. We also have received \$1,100 in donations from our three parishes and the Freeport Lions Club already, and we're hoping to match or even go beyond last year's total of \$11,341. At 15 cents a meal, that would purchased enough food to package 75,610 meals. Could we consider a goal of \$12,000?
