

ood for Kidz is on for Saturday, March 28. This is our special tri-parish and community opportunity to channel some of our Lenten almsgiving to help feed starving children worldwide.

Goal # 1: to raise \$12,000 to pay for the dry food products for 80,000 meals that will be brought to the Community Center in Freeport by truck on Saturday, March 28 (that's just 15 cents per meal!). To do this, we need your donations or pledges in the next two weeks so we can tell Food for Kidsz much of the food product to load on the semi for packaging. We don't want to run out of food to package and have to send volunteers home early.

Goal # 2: to gather two shifts of 125 volunteers each to measure the ingredients into bags of six meals each, seal then and pack them in boxes to be shipped to carefully guarded and supervised programs that feed starving children locally and throughout the world. A hungry family just adds hot water to the dried food and supplements and our fifteen cent meal will support a starving child for a day!

TO DONATE MONEY to buy the food products, please make your check out to Food for Kidz, put your donation in an envelope labeled FOOD FOR KIDZ (add your name, envelope number and



parish if you want your gift to be included in your annual contribution report), then drop it in the collection or get it to the Triparish Office by Wednesday, March 18. We'd like to raise \$12,000 to purchase food for 80,000 meals. Donations and pledges so far total \$5,615, so we still have \$ 6,385 to go to reach our goal.


