**From the Pastor...**

**C**ollection for Nepal Earthquake Victims As a result of the vast destruction following the 7.8 magnitude earthquake which struck Nepal April 25, thousands have been left homeless and thousands more are lacking basic necessities. In his letter to the US Bishops, Archbishop Kurtz wrote, "Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of our brothers and sisters affected by this powerful earthquake. The earthquake struck the Kathmandu valley, which is densely populated with nearly 2.5 million people. Tens of thousands of families are sleeping outside in Kathmandu and require shelter and protection from the cold and relentless rain, which has worsened conditions. Aftershocks continue—one reaching 6.7 magnitude and another 5.4 magnitude—increasing fear, causing further damage to buildings and interrupting rescue operations. Most markets in Kathmandu are closed. People urgently need basic essentials. Shelter, blankets, safe water, food, medical care, hygiene and counseling are priorities. Hygiene and sanitation are critical to preventing waterborne diseases."

To show our solidarity with our brothers and sisters who are suffering as a result of this earthquake, Bishop Kettler asks every parish of our diocese to take up a special collection for the victims of this earthquake. Put your donation in an envelope with your name, parish and envelope number on it and drop it in the collection by the weekend of May 16-17 so it can be sent to the chancery soon.

**M**ass at Lake Maria Wednesday, May 20 We all have special needs, and on Wednesday, May 20, at 8:00 pm, our tri-parish community is invited to gather at Lake Maria to request Mary's intercession in this month dedicated to her as we deal with many difficult issues, such as the bird flu virus, the need for rain and good weather for our growing season, the desire for peace and harmony in our cities and among nations of the world, and helping victims of natural disasters such as the earth quake in Nepal. Please plan of taking this opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist celebrating **new life** in the midst of God's awesome creation!
