From the Pastor...

Collection for Nepal Earthquake Victims All of us are certainly aware of the vast destruction that has taken place as a result of the 7.8 magnitude earthquake which struck Nepal in the late morning of April 25. Thousands have been left homeless and thousands more are lacking basic necessities. This past week the Bishops of the United States received a letter regarding this devastating natural disaster from Archbishop Joseph Kurtz, President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

In his letter, Archbishop Kurtz wrote, "Our Church mourns the terrible suffering of our brothers and sisters affected by this powerful earthquake. The earthquake struck the Kathmandu valley, which is densely populated with nearly 2.5 million people. Tens of thousands of families are sleeping outside in Kathmandu and require shelter and protection from the cold and relentless rain, which has worsened conditions. Aftershocks continue—one reaching 6.7 magnitude and another 5.4 magnitude—increasing fear, causing further damage to buildings and interrupting rescue operations. Most markets in Kathmandu are closed. People urgently need basic essentials. Shelter, blankets, safe water, food, medical care, hygiene and counseling are priorities. Hygiene and sanitation are critical to preventing waterborne diseases."

To show our solidarity with our brothers and sisters who are suffering as a result of this earthquake, Bishop Kettler is asking that every parish of the Diocese of Saint Cloud take up a special collection for the victims of this earthquake. Please put your donation in an envelope with your name, parish and envelope number on it and drop it in the collection on either the weekend of May 9-10 or May 16-17. The bishops realize that the following weekend, May 23-24, is the collection for the Holy Father, but both causes are important.

Mass at Lake Maria Wednesday, May 20 We all have special needs in our tri-parish community, and on Wednesday, May 20, at 8:00pm, we will have the opportunity to request Mary's intercession in this month dedicated to her as we deal with many different issues, such as the bird flu virus, the need for rain and good weather for our growing season, the desire for peace and harmony in our cities and among nations of the world, and helping victims of natural disasters such as the earth quake in Nepal. Please plan of taking this opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist celebrating **new life** in the midst of God's awesome creation!

Charities of the Quarter At our three to parish pastoral council meetings last week, two special causes were singled out as our "charities of the quarter". The St Rose of Lima council will send a donation on behalf of the parish to the Mary and Mike Eggert family of St. Francis. Daughter Aubriella (born Nov. 2014) was diagnosed on Feb. 27 with spinal muscular atrophy (SMA), a genetic disease affecting the part of the nervous system that controls voluntary muscle movement. The Sacred Heart and Immaculate Conception councils will send donations to Covenant House in New York City to help the staff there to continue ministering to thousands of homeless kids that come to their crises shelter for a hot meal, some clean clothes, and a safe place to sleep. Members of our three parishes are invited to add to the parish donation to these "charities of the quarter" by labeling their donation "Charity of the Quarter" and dropping their gift in the Sunday collection.
