In a letter dated May 26, Bishop Kettler wrote:
"Dear Father Klassen: With this letter I am pleased to appoint you to the Church of the Holy Cross, North Prairie and the Church of the Holy Trinity, Royalton, effective at noon on July 1,

2015.... This assignment is made following your presentation by Abbot John Klassen, OSB. I would like you to announce your new assignment and your replacement in your parishes the weekend of May 30-31, so that the new assignments are communicated throughout the Diocese on the same weekend.

Reverend Daniel Walz will be the new pastor of the Church of the Sacred Heart, Freeport, the Church of the Immaculate Conception, New Munich, and the Church of Saint Rose of Lima, Saint Rosa. I am deeply grateful to you, Father Roger, for accepting this new pastoral responsibility in North Prairie and Royalton.
