From the Pastor...

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, In our gospel this weekend we hear about James and John asking to sit at Jesus' right and left in the Kingdom. What ambition these two have. We can look at this in two ways. First we can say, who do they think they are? To ask for the two highest places in the Kingdom seems pretty arrogant on their part. What was their understanding of what the Kingdom of God would be like? Secondly, we could say, they wanted to strive for the highest place. They loved Jesus so much that they wanted to be as close to Him as they possibly could. We face similar situations in each of our lives. We may look at people and make a quick judgment about their motives. We need to have understanding of the person and the desire that lay deep within them. Jesus didn't scold them for seeking these places but rather said to them, "Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?" They replied, "We can." They are eager to do whatever it may take. They didn't understand that there would be suffering and sacrifice that go along with following Jesus. Sometimes we too want certain things without realizing that suffering and sacrifice will accompany it. Jesus reminds the twelve as well as you and me, we need to be servants of all. This is a good question for each of us to ask of ourselves, Am I a servant? Do I seek to serve the needs of others? Jesus said, "The Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." May we always seek to serve one another and be willing to give our life for the good of others.
