My dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

In the Creation story God create all things and He said that it was good.

There was only one time that God said something wasn't good and we heard that in our first reading this weekend from the Book of Genesis, "It is not good for the man to be alone." Our Scriptures are filled with the theme of marriage. God has looked so highly upon marriage that He has blessed it as a sacrament.
