**F**rom the Pastor... My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, change can be exciting and fun but change can also be challenging. Many of you may have noticed that there have been some changes with the bulletin. Let me explain one aspect of the changes. The three circles, one for each of the three parishes, being united and intertwined as a parish cluster working together and sharing your pastor. A circle has no beginning and no end. The circle is a symbol for God who has no beginning and no end. Our three parishes are part of the body of Christ. If you look closely at how the three circles are united you will hopefully see another symbol, a fish symbol. In the early years of the church, believers called themselves "sons of the celestial *Ichthus*" (Greek for *fish*). In the second century, Tertullian wrote, "We small fish, like our Fish, Jesus Christ, swim in the [baptismal] water, and we can be saved only by remaining in it." The baptismal font is a *piscina*, which literally means "fishpond." In the third century, Cyprian wrote, "It is in the water that we are reborn, in the likeness of Christ our Master, the Fish." The fish became a common sign used by persecuted Christians to identify themselves as believers - a secret sign of faith. Another link between faith and the fish symbol is seen in the Greek word *ichthus*, spelled Iota CHi THeta Upsilon Sigma. This is an acrostic for "Jesus Christ, of God, the Son, the Savior": Iesous (Jesus) CHristos (Christ) THEou (of God) Uiou (the Son) Soter (the Savior).
