From the Pastor...

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, In our gospel this week we hear Jesus say, "**Anyone who gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ, amen, I say to you, will surely not lose his reward.**" In this one line we hear about the importance of giving in the simplest way and the promise by Jesus of being rewarded.
